WINEMAKING

The grapes, coming from our property Quinta da Cabreira in the Douro Superior sub-region, were taken to the winery in plastic boxes and rigorously inspected on a sorting table on arrival. The grapes were then completely destemmed and slightly crushed. After this, the must was transferred to temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks.

AGEING

In French oak barrels for about 12 months.

TASTING

Colour: Deep purple.

Nose: Intense and deep on the nose, with fresh notes of wild berry fruit, elegant aromas of violets and delicate hints of cocoa.

Palate: Balanced beginning, leading to a wine with great volume and a tight-knit structure made of round and silky tannins. Everything is in perfect harmony with fresh retronasal aromas of berry fruit. Balanced and lingering finish.
